

Continuing Education Requirements

All real estate brokers and sales agents need to complete 45 hours of continuing education. Specific requirements vary based on your license type and renewal status.

First-time sales agent

renewals require:



18 hours of Consumer Protection courses.


15 hours comprised of five separate three-hour courses in:

- o Agency;
- o Fair Housing;
- o Trust Funds;
- o Ethics: and
- o Risk Management.

The remaining 12 hours comprised of either Consumer Protection or Consumer Service courses, including the Office Management and Supervision course if they choose to take it.

First-time broker

renewals require:



18 hours of Consumer Protection courses.

18 hours comprised of six separate three-hour courses in:

- o Agency;
- o Fair Housing;
- o Trust Funds;
- o Ethics:
- o Risk Management; and
- o Office Management and Supervision.

The remaining 9 hours comprised of Consumer Protection or Consumer Service courses.

Broker and sales agent subsequent

renewals require:



18 hours of Consumer Protection courses.

18 hours comprised of six separate three-hour courses in:

- o Agency;
- o Fair Housing;
- o Trust Funds;
- o Fthics:
- o Risk Management; and
- o Office Management and Supervision.

8 hours in a survey course covering all six subjects.

The remaining hours comprised of Consumer Protection or Consumer Service courses.



Every first tuesday continuing education package meets the requirements for all broker and sales agent renewals, whether first-time or subsequent. Each package includes:

- 18 hours comprised of six separate three-hour courses in Agency, Fair Housing, Trust Funds, Ethics, Risk Management and Office Management and Supervision; and
- 27 hours of Consumer Protection courses.
