



Your property taxes are due December 10

This is a friendly reminder that **December 10th** is the deadline to pay the first installment of your **property taxes!**

When your property taxes are not impounded (included in your mortgage payment), you are responsible for paying your property taxes directly to the County Tax Collector twice a year.

Property taxes are due and payable in two installments. The first installment is due November 1st, and delinquent December 10th. The second installment is due February 1st, and **delinquent April 10th**.

If you do not pay either property tax installment by its delinquent date, a 10% penalty is added to the payment. However, when December 10th or April 10th falls on a weekend, your taxes are not considered delinquent until 5:00 p.m. on the next business day. Further, if you fail to pay either or both installments by June 30, your property taxes may become defaulted.
